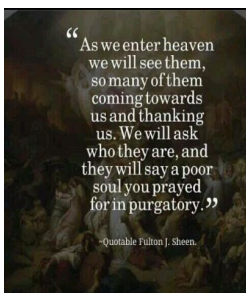
PARISH COUNCIL: Parish council met this past week. Copies of the minutes are available on the table in the lobby of church.
