TITHING: Collections are down and expenses are up. The Rectory HVAC system is in need of repair or replacement and either one will deeply cut into our reserves. \$30.00 is greatly less than a tank of gas at current gas prices, and yet many of our parishioners are seemingly unable to contribute to the support of our parish church. Down the road this can lead to the question of will we survive as a Parish Church at New Hope, KY, if we can not maintain the financial support to take care of our parish community. To date, we are approximately \$4,000 less than what we received in collections last year.
