**INDULGENCES:** + Several Partial Indulgences may be obtained per day, but only one Plenary Indulgence per day. + A Plenary Indulgence is granted when the rosary is recited in a church or oratory or when it is recited in a family, a religious community, or a pious association. + A Partial Indulgence is granted for its recitation in all other circumstances. + A recitation of one set of mysteries (five decades) is sufficient for obtaining the Plenary Indulgence, but these five decades must be recited without interruption.
